## Home Learning Expectations

- Homework will now be set on Google Classroom with alternating weeks of Maths and English on Fridays and should be returned on Tuesdays.
- Children are expected to be reading everyday with an adult and write a comment in their reading record. Their reading record will be checked everyday by the class teacher.
- Children will be given a list of words from the year 3-4 statutory spelling list as part of their homework each week.
- Children are required to practice their times table every day as times tables are fundamental to support them with the Year 5 and 6 Curriculum.
- The national times table check is a test for all year four pupils that takes place from Monday 3rd June 2024.

## Attendance and Punctuality

- We believe that regular attendance is clearly linked to pupils making good progress in their learning.
- It ensures that pupils settle into school and experience the stability and security they need in order to achieve their best.
- At a minimum we expect children to be in school for $96 \%$ of the time. This can still equate to 8 days of learning missed.
- If your child’s attendance drops down to below $90 \%$, this means almost 4 weeks of lost learning!
