We will not be posting any more work for the children on DB Primary, we hope you have appreciated the home learning support during this strange lockdown period.

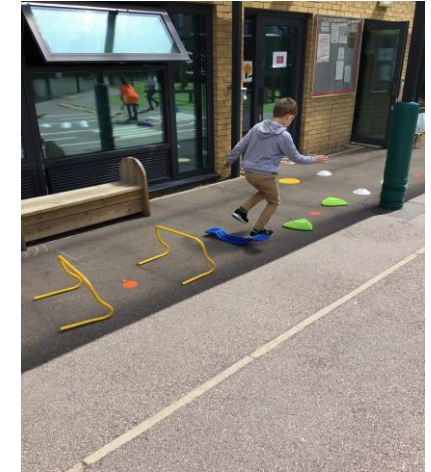
