Dear Parents and carers,

For the next 4 weeks we are asking you to support us with times tables - in the table below you can see which tables each year group should know. Times tables are the basis to many math's skills and sound knowledge of them is imperative to good mathematical progress and attainment. Please practice these at home, as much as possible. We will be having interclass competitions and school 'bubble' times table competitions later this half term.

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| Year 1 | Count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. Recall and use all doubles to 10 and corresponding halves. |
| Year 2 | Counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 from 0 and in 10's from any number. Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables, including recognising odd and even numbers. |
| Year 3 | Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables. |
| Year 4 | Recall and use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 12x12. (All year 4 children will have their multiplication skills formally tested from June 2021) |
| Year 5 | Revision of all times tables and division facts up to 12x12. |
| Year 6 | Revision of all times tables and division facts up to 12x12. |

How can you help at home?

- Practise times tables at home by old fashioned chanting
- Ask your child times tables questions out of order - such as 11 x 12, then 5x6
