Government announcement on the delay to re-opening primary schools – what it means for us

As you will have seen yesterday, the government has announced that primary schools in Tier 4 areas where coronavirus rates are particularly high **will remain closed until at least Monday, 18 January.**

We are in one of these areas and therefore will be closed.

The government says it will be making a further announcement on when primary schools will be able to re-open again.

Key worker children can still attend school – but you need to contact us first

The children of key workers and some other identified children that we will be contacting directly are still able to come to school from Tuesday, 5 January (School hours: 9am-3pm).

If you would like a key worker place you will need to call the school office (020 8805 9811) on Monday, 4 January (10am-12pm) and also let us know which days you would like, so we can organise appropriate levels of staffing.

Key worker children will need to report to the main school office. Please maintain social distancing at all times. No other entrances will be open.

You will need to bring with you evidence that you are a key worker on your first day.

Wrap around care

There will be no wrap around care available at this time.

Home learning

We will be writing again very shortly to set out the arrangements for home learning for all the children who will not be attending school.

Free school meals

If you are eligible for free school meals, you will receive a voucher which the school will email to you early next week.
