Design and Technology

Science

- This term we will be learning all about Evolution and Inheritance.
- We will be studying how living things have adapted and changed over time.
- Children will learn about specific animals all over the world and how they have evolved.
- We will investigate what fossils are and how they have taught us about animals and plants that lived long before us. Celebrating important figures such as Mary Anning.
- Children will consider the reasons for similarities and differences between offspring. We will be gaining a deeper understanding about what we inherit from our parents.

Geography

- We will continue to learn about the world around us by looking at where the key events in our Science unit happened.

History

- We will be creating timelines while we learn about the evolution of different species and even how technology has evolved over time.

Maths

- In our final weeks of Maths at Enfield Heights we will be revising certain areas of Maths we feel we need to keep working on for our SATs.
- We will be working really hard on our arithmetic to get ready for our Arithmetic Test – finding fractions of amounts; finding percentages; adding, subtracting and multiplying whole numbers, fractions and decimals; dividing whole numbers ... and more!
- In our final weeks we will be using our maths skills to help make a profit from our Virgin Money project.
- Finally (if we have time) we will be having a look at some secondary school maths ... and seeing if it is as hard as everyone suggests!

Music

- As part of our leavers' assembly we will be writing, practising and performing a song.

PE

- We will continue preparing for sports day with a focus on team events and working collaboratively to achieve our goals.

English

- Children will be taking part in the Virgin Money project to see how far they can make £5 go.
- We will be working hard to increase awareness of our various projects designed to raise money for Water Aid and for our own class trips.
- In class students will design and produce posters, radio adverts and TV adverts in groups to support our great cause.
- 6S will be reminiscing about their time at Enfield Heights when they write their entries for the yearbook.
- They will also be working on their speaking skills when they will be thinking about some of their favourite memories of EHA. We will be learning about story-telling and how to tell funny, scary and even sad anecdotes.
- Children will also be helping to write their leavers' assembly.
