On **Wednesday 4th May, Year 4 and the Enfield Heights Choir** will be taking part in a concert at the **O2 Arena** held by **Young Voices**, an organisation who run "the largest school choir concerts in the world". I would like to apologise if the level of commitment has been unclear up until now.

The concert

On this day, our singers will rehearse as part of a choir of up to 8,000 children from schools across London and the South East of England. The music team (Mr Merit-Hall Ms. Rilievo, and Mr Okine) have been teaching the repertoire of songs written and arranged for the concert. This is a fantastic opportunity for your child to perform in a world famous arena, in front of a live audience.

In addition, details of how your child can access recordings, backing tracks and lyrics for each of the songs has been, shared on DB Primary so they can get familiar with and practice them in their own time as well. We strongly encourage that our students dedicate as much time as they can to learning the songs at home as well as in school, so that they are as ready as possible for the big day!
