Re: Uniform

Dear Parents/Carers,

From **September, it is important that all children are wearing the correct school uniform** from YR-Y6. We expect children to adhere to the schools uniform policy. The uniform policy will be enforced with regular uniform checks.

We consider it a parental responsibility to make sure children are dressed correctly every day. Please note that if the uniform guidelines are not followed parents/carers will be invited in to discuss these concerns with a senior member of staff.

Uniform
White shirt (long or short sleeved) – no polo shirts
School tie (elastic for KS1 and Reception, full tie for KS2)
V-neck grey jumper or cardigan (school logo version from Smiths shop and all spares without logo from supermarket)
Grey skirt or grey pinafore or
Grey trousers or grey shorts
White, dark grey or black tights
White socks
Red and White Gingham dress for Summer
Black shoes

All PE kits need to be supplied in a burgundy PE drawstring bag that is clearly labeled with the child's full name and class can be purchased from school uniform shop.

Black Shoes

Black school shoes must be flat. All shoes must be fully fitted (no sling backs or peep toes) and must be easy to fasten by your child. They should not have any flashing lights as this is extremely distracting

for all children. These are health and safety rules. Pupils who are not wearing safe footwear which adheres to school uniform rules will be asked to change into plimsolls for the remainder of the school day. If plimsolls are unavailable, children will not be allowed on the playground as physical activity in the wrong footwear can cause a huge risk.

Headwear

Headscarves and turbans must be plain and either plain black, dark grey, burgundy or white in colour NO branded or printed headwear is allowed, plain black, burgundy or grey hats/sunhats. All long hair must be tied back.

School Bags

All children require an Academy book bag bearing the school logo, these can also be obtained from Smiths Schoolwear.

Jewellery

Just a reminder that the school has a no jewellery policy unless it is of religious significance. No jewellery can be worn in PE lessons.

The only earrings allowed in school are small stud earrings and children must be able to take these out and put them back in by themselves on PE days. No nail varnish or lip gloss is allowed in school.

Please remember to label all uniform and PE kit with your child's full name.
