Our community run is rescheduled to take place on **Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2024** from **1.45pm at St Georges Field** (the field at the end of Palmers Lane). All children are required to wear their PE kit on that day. The Castles are happy to promote our Summer Fair event online / on social media promotions, etc.

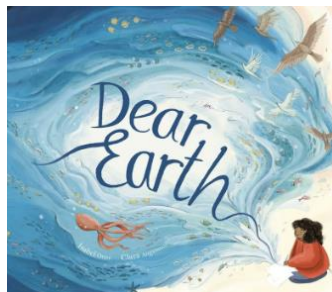


