Boards are either stacked into soft ground or tied to gate post with wire. No holes will be drilled into your property. Typically, boards go up to 3-4 weeks before our event and are taken down a week after our fair on 6th July.

Please remember that all children must wear the correct school uniform from YR-Y6. We expect children to adhere




to the school's uniform policy. You can find a quick reminder of our school uniform requirements in my previous communication here.
