Dear parents and carers,

Harvest has always been a special time where people have harvested, and been thankful for, the crops they have grown. In today's world, many of us are lucky to buy our food from local shops and supermarkets.

In celebration of harvest and linked to our school value of 'Being a Force for Positive Change', we have shared an assembly with the children and are collecting foods which we will donate to the North Enfield Foodbank to support families in need.

The North Enfield Foodbank opened in April 2012 to help support those in our community facing a sudden crisis with food support. The foodbank is a project founded by Jubilee Church (www.jubileechurchlondon.org) and is supported by local churches and community groups, working together towards stopping hunger in our local area. Individuals or families are referred to the foodbank by local organisations and care professionals in order to receive 3 days' worth of nutritionally balanced food and support.
