

Year 6 Residential trip to Danbury

Wednesday 9th October 2024

Dear Parents/Carers,

In year 6, the children will have the exciting opportunity to spend three days (two nights) away on a residential school trip at Danbury Activity Centre (Essex). This is a wonderful experience to further build their independence and resilience before they move onto secondary school. This will also be a memorable opportunity to cap the end of their school journey with their classmates. On the residential, they will have the opportunity to take part in a range of adventurous activities.

Details are as follows:

- Date: Wednesday 18th June Friday 20th June 2025.
- Place: Essex Outdoors Danbury Activity Centre, Well lane, Essex CM3 4M3
- Travel: School Mini-bus / coach dependent on number of children attending
- Cost: The approximate cost of the trip, if all pupils attend, is £200 per child.

The cost may change per child, depending on the number of children who attend. Unfortunately, without sufficient uptake, the residential will not be able to take place.

Families will need to register whether their child is attending the residential by giving consent on Arbor by **Friday 18**th **October 2024**.

Once we have final numbers, we will then calculate the final cost per child. This will cover the cost of all food, drinks, accommodation and activities and transport.

When the final cost of the trip has been confirmed, an initial non-refundable deposit of £100 will be payable to secure your child's place by the <u>end of November</u>. The rest of the payments will be broken down into smaller instalments each month ending at the start of May.
