Children will learn to:

Reading: In whole class reading, children, exploring a variety of text types designed to capture their interest and develop their comprehension ability.

Suspense Narrative:

Children will write a suspense narrative inspired by a video stimulus using expanded noun phrases and conjunctions.

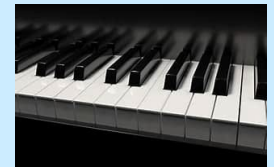
Balanced arguments:

Children will write a balanced argument which focuses on the question, "Should children be allowed to have mobile phones?" They will gather data and form arguments for both sides of the debate.



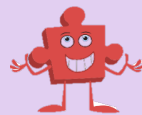
Music

Children will learn to read musical notation and identify ascending and descending notes. They will also learn how to play a 5-note piece of music.



PHSE: Changing Me

Children will be learning about celebrating the differences between us and what makes us unique.



Physical Education

PE –Outdoor – Netball

Children will focus on improving their netball skills, including ball handling, landing and shooting. They will also learn effective tactics for attack and defence, applying these in core task games where they will play to the best of their ability.

PE- Indoor – Dance

Children will be learning about processional dance. They will develop their fluency and rhythm focusing on patterns and movement. They will then apply these skills to perform in a group.



Spanish



This term children will learn how to discuss jobs that they do and don't want to do. They will also learn how to articulate places that they would like to travel to/live.

Children will learn why the Rosh Hashanah is important to Jewish people and some of the customs. Children will also learn some of the ways Jewish people celebrate Yom Kippur.

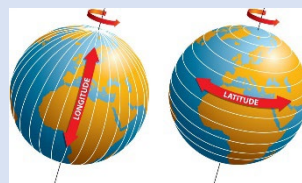


History
