I am pleased to announce that on **Wednesday 23rd April**, we will be holding our second **Hispanic Culture Day** at Enfield Heights Academy, where we celebrate the language and culture of Spain and other Spanish-speaking countries.

On this day, our children will enjoy a range of class-based and out-of-class activities to mark the occasion. Traditional dance, cultural food sessions and craft activities such as making maracas, piñatas and mosaics will be on offer.
