**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- Any year group can enter
- Acts can be solo, pairs or small groups (we are restricting groups to no more than 4 people)
- Acts can be anything, e.g. comedy, magic, singing, gymnastic sequence, dance, karate demonstration, debating, story writing etc.
- Performances should be between 3 and 5 minutes
- Children must supply their own music (if needed) on USB or their own device

**Class Rounds (Thursday 22nd May)**

Children should start practising straight away. Children will need to tell their teacher (as soon as possible) that they would like to enter so that the teacher can ensure all children get to perform in the Class Rounds. Acts will perform to their own classes and the children then have a blind vote, voting for the two acts they would like to go through to the semi-finals.

**The Semi-Final (Monday 10<sup>th</sup> June)**

The two acts from each class will perform to the whole school in the hall, whereby a vote will be taken by the children.

**The Grand Final (Monday the 16<sup>th</sup> of June) after school.**

The Grand Final will take place after school at 3:30 PM. One act from each class will compete against representatives from the other six classes. A panel of four neutral guest judges will help select the winners. All adults, friends, and family are warmly invited to attend.

Refreshments will be available for purchase, kindly provided by our amazing friends at HPSA. We hope that children will want to take part and enjoy celebrating the many talents we have at Enfield Heights Academy.
