Year 2 visit to the Tower of London

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Learning Journey - 'Gunpowder, Treason and Plot' - next half term, we will be taking the children to the Tower of London.

Children will learn more about the Tower's role as a prison and they will go through the events leading up to, and following, Guy Fawkes' imprisonment.

Details are as follows:

Date: 14th November 2025

Place: Tower of London, EC3N 4AB

Travel: Bus, overground and underground train

Times: 8:45-3:15

Cost: A contribution of **£8** is needed to cover the cost of the trip. Unfortunately, without sufficient uptake, the sessions will not take place.

The children will need a **packed lunch, water bottle (both to be packed in a backpack)** and comfortable **walking shoes** (preferably trainers). The children need to **wear school uniform** and a **jacket** with a hood advised in the event of rainy weather.

If your child usually gets a free school lunch, we will provide them with a packed lunch for the day.
