Maths

Children will learn to:

Fractions decimals and percentages

Children will begin to apply the four operations to working with fractions. We will add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions. Pupils will also develop their ability to identify equivalent fractions and find the lowest common denominator

Geometry

Children will learn and apply angle facts to pairs of lines and shapes. They will use their knowledge of angles to compare the properties of geometric shapes. Pupils will then work on recognising, comparing and building 3D shapes.



English

Reading: In whole class reading, children, exploring a variety of text types designed to capture their interest and develop their comprehension ability.

Writing:

Suspense Narrative:

Children will write a suspense narrative inspired by a video stimulus using expanded noun phrases and dialogue. We will study techniques to build suspense and tension within our writing and then innovate the story.

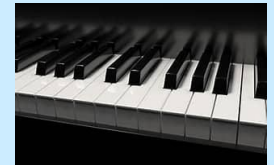
Balanced arguments:

Children will write a balanced argument which focuses on the question, "Should children be allowed to have mobile phones?" They will gather data and form arguments for both sides of the debate. They will practise writing in a formal register and justifying their arguments.



Music

Children will learn perform a chordal accompaniment, perform ascending and descending melodies and learn to play a Christmas carol.



PHSE: Changing Me

Children will be learning about celebrating the differences between us and what makes us unique.



Physical Education

PE –Outdoor – NFL

children will consolidate and practise passing, moving and defending. Children will then learn and apply offensive and defensive tactics and apply these to small games. Children will then bring all their learning together to compete in a tournament.



PE- Indoor – Gymnastics

Children will learn about the concept of matching and mirroring and practise with the use of apparatus. Children will then combine these concepts into a sequence which they will perform to the rest of the class.



Spanish



This term children will learn how to discuss jobs that they do and don't want to do. They will also learn how to articulate places that they would like to travel to/live.

Art: collage



Children will be studying the artwork of Vanessa German (sculpture work on transformation and healing). Children will then create their own collage which links to our force for positive change initiative

RE: Judaism

Children will learn why the Rosh Hashanah is important to Jewish people and some of the customs. Children will also learn some of the ways Jewish people celebrate Yom Kippur.



History

The children will review their knowledge of British History and significant historical events and periods around the world.
