- Tinned meat and Fish
- Long life ready meals/ noodles
- Tinned rice pudding/ custard

- Washing powder and cleaning products
- Toiletries (e.g. soap, shower gel, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toilet roll etc)

If you are able to donate, your child will place the gift under our school Christmas tree. They will then be able to decorate a Christmas decoration (writing their name and donation) to hang on our Christmas Tree.
