Dear Parents and Carers,

We know many children enjoy playing online games, and one popular choice is **Roblox**. As part of our commitment to keeping children safe online, we wanted to share some important information about the game's age requirements.

Roblox's **minimum age for creating an account is 7 years old**. This means that **children younger than 7 should not be using Roblox**. The age limit is in place to help ensure that children have the maturity to understand the game's features, follow safety rules, and make safe choices when interacting with others online.

If your child is under 7 and interested in Roblox, we recommend exploring alternative age-appropriate games such as Numbots. School has provided you with a password for your child to explore this interactive game, which will help develop their maths skills.

We also encourage you to:

- Talk to your child about online safety and being kind to others online.
- Use parental controls and privacy settings if your child plays Roblox once they are old enough.
- Keep gaming devices in shared family spaces so you can monitor play.

If you'd like more advice about online safety or suitable games for younger children, please feel free to speak to us — we're happy to help.

This session, run by ECP Safeguarding consultant will be exploring not only apps, games but also risk of cyberbullying, grooming online and uncovering the reality of social media's impact on mental health.
