Maths

Children will learn to:

Addition and subtraction

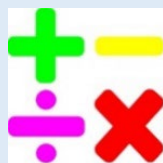
- use the + and – symbols.
- write mathematical statements
- solve problems involving addition and subtraction.
- Missing number problems

Mass and Weight

- Measuring, comparing and recording.

Capacity

- Measuring, comparing and recording.



English

Reading:

In whole class reading, children, will be exploring a variety of text types designed to capture their interest and develop their comprehension ability.

Writing:

Fiction: Children will orally retell the story Supertato. They will use a five-part story technique and use sentence starters to retell the story.

Non-Fiction: Children will write a newspaper report about the Evil Pea visiting EHA.

Poetry: Children will experiment with poetic language and understanding how to apply fruit and vegetable vocabulary to shape poems



Music

This term, the children will recognise a melody and sing as an ensemble and listen to and discuss the lyrics of a song.



PHSE: Relationships

Children will be learning about relationships and identifying the members of my family and understand that there are lots of different families.



Physical Education

PE –Outdoor – Athletics

Children will focus on developing the ability to throw an object and to the ability to move at speed. They will learn how to jump safely and in different ways.



PE- Indoor – Team building

Children will be learning team building skills and the skills required to make an effective team. They will be exploring why it's important to trust or partner (team) if we are going to be successful.

Spanish



This term, the children will be identifying fruit in Spanish. They will be learning how to use the plural of nouns for fruits.

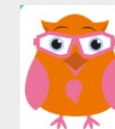
Art: drawing
