As the incident occurred during drop-off, some children may have witnessed it or heard about it during the day. We recognise this may have unsettled them. Staff have been available to support children in school today, and if your child has any concerns, please encourage them to speak with a trusted adult at home or a member of staff at school.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind all members of our community to take extra care during drop-off and collection times, including remaining vigilant and using designated safe stopping areas.

We will continue to reinforce road safety with pupils as part of our ongoing curriculum and will also share reminders with families.
